Acknowledgement of Country

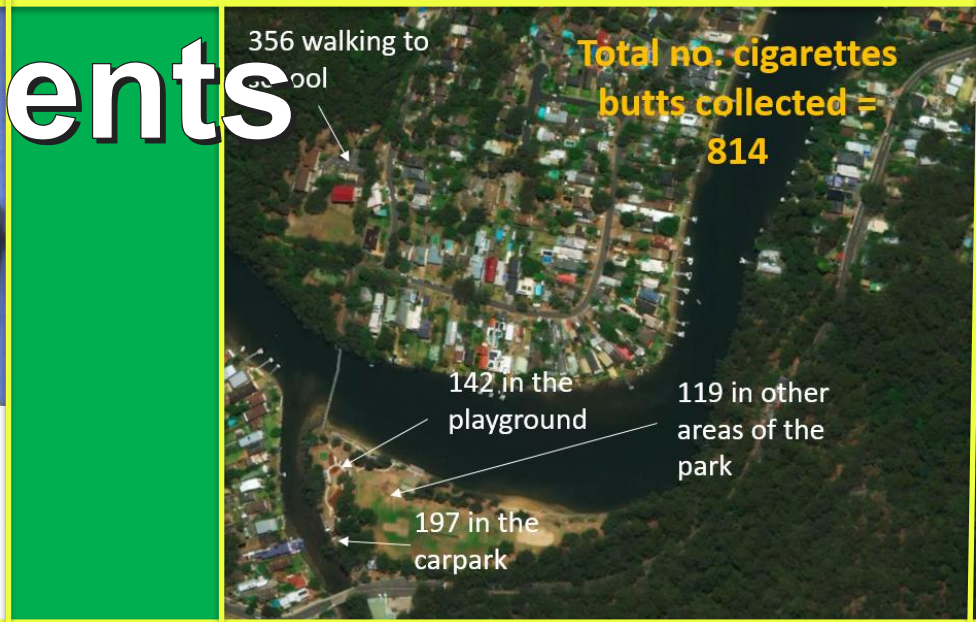
